This is a ‘Meccan’ sūrah.

The surah that opens with the mention of God as the Lord of The Daybreak and that teaches one to seek refuge in Him from the evil in creation and from all who envy the blessings of God in others. It takes its name from “the daybreak” (*al-falaq*) mentioned in verse 1. The surah is used as an invocation against evil.

It is narrated from the Holy Prophet (s.a.w.) that whoever recites this surah in the month of Ramadhan in any of his prayers, it is as if he has fasted in Makkah and he will get the reward for performing *Hajj* and ‘*Umra*.

Imam Muhammad al-Baqir (a.s.) said that in the prayer of *Shafa’a* (in *Salaatul-layl*) one should recite surah *al-Falaq* in the first *rak’aat* and *an-Naas* in the second.
