Duas on Sighting the New Moon of the Month of Ramadhan

When your eyes fall on the new moon, you must not point to it; rather you should turn yourself towards the kiblah, raise both your hands towards the sky, and address the new moon with the following words:

<u>mp3</u>

Your and my Lord is Allah; the Lord of the worlds.

O Allah, (please do) cause this crescent

to carry with it for us security, faith,

safety, Islam,

and expedition to whatever You love and please.

O Allah, (please do) bless us in this month,

confer upon us with its goodness and aid,

and save us from its harm, evil, ordeals, and sedition.

Your and my Lord is Allah; the Lord of the worlds.

O Allah, (please do) cause this crescent to carry with it for us security, faith,

safety, Islam,

and expedition to whatever You love and please.

O Allah, (please do) bless us in this month,

confer upon us with its goodness and aid,

and save us from its harm, evil, ordeals, and sedition.

It has been narrated that when the Holy Prophet ملى الله عليه وآله وسلم would see the new moon of the Month of Ramadhan, he would turn his face to the kiblah direction and say the following:

<u>mp3</u>

O Allah, (please do) cause this crescent to carry with it for us security, faith,

safety, Islam,

encompassing wellbeing, repulsion of ailments,

and assistance to offer prayers, observe fasting, do acts of worship,

and recite the Qur'an.

O Allah, (please do) keep us sound for the month of Ramadhan,

accept our deeds during it,

and save us during it,

حَتَّىٰ يَنْقَضِيَ عَنَّا شَهْرُ رَمَضَانَ

so that the month of Ramadhan will not elapse

unless You have pardoned us, forgiven us, and had mercy upon us.

Imam Ja`far al-Sadiq عليه السلام is also reported to have said: When you see the new moon of the Month of Ramadhan, you may say the following:

O Allah, the month of Ramadhan has commenced,

You have made obligatory upon us to observe fasting during it,

and revealed the Qur'an in it

as guidance for people and clear proofs of true guidance and distinction (between the right and the wrong).

O Allah, (please) help us observe fasting in it,

وَتَقَبَّلْهُ مِنَّا

accept it from us,

وَسَلِّمْنَا فِيهِ

keep us safe during it,

وَسَلِّمْنَا مِنْهُ

help us observe it adequately,

and keep it sound for us with easiness and good health from You.

You verily have power over all things.

O All-beneficent! O All-merciful!

<u>Dua 43 – Sahifa Sajjadiyah – Upon</u> <u>Sighting the New Moon of Month of</u> <u>Ramdhan</u>

It is recommended, at the sight of the new moon of Ramadhan, to say the supplication number forty-three of the *al-Sahifah al-Kamilah al-Sajjadiyyah*. Sayyid Ibn Tawus narrated that Imam `Ali ibn al-Husayn Zayn al-Abidin عليه, once, gazed at the new moon of Ramadhan while he was walking. He therefore stopped and said the following:

<u>mp3</u>

أَيُّهَا ٱلْخُلْقُ ٱلْمُطِيعُ

O obedient creature,

speedy and untiring,

frequenter of the mansions of determination,

moving about in the sphere of governance!

I have faith in Him Who lights up darkness through you,

illuminates jet-black shadows by you,

appointed you one of the signs of His kingdom

and one of the marks of His authority,

so, He identified time through You,

and humbled you through increase and decrease,

and rising and setting,

وَٱلْإِنَارَةِ وَٱلْكُسُوفِ

and illumination and eclipse.

In all of this you are obedient to Him,

and prompt toward His will.

Glory be to Him! How wonderful is what He has arranged in Your situation!

How subtle what He has made for Your task!

He has made You the key to a new month for a new situation.

So I ask Allah, my Lord and Your Lord,

my Creator and Your Creator,

my Determiner and Your Determiner,

my Form-giver and Your Form-giver,

that He bless Muhammad and his Household

and appoint You a crescent of blessings not effaced by days

and of purity not defiled by sins;

a crescent of security from blights

and of safety from evil deeds;

a crescent of auspiciousness containing

no misfortune,

of prosperity accompanied by no adversity,

of ease not mixed with difficulty,

of good unstained by evil;

a crescent of security and faith,

favor and good-doing,

وسكلامة وإسكرم

safety and submission!

O Allah, bless Muhammad and his Household,

place us among the most satisfied of those over whom the crescent has risen,

the purest of those who have looked upon it,

the most fortunate of those who have worshiped You under it;

give us the success during [the new month] to repent,

preserve us within it from misdeeds and exposition to punishment,

allot to us within it thanksgiving for Your favor,

clothe us during it in the shields of well-being,

and complete for us Your kindness by perfecting therein obedience to You!

Surely You are All-kind, Praiseworthy.

And bless Muhammad and his Household, the good, the pure.

And grant us aid from You to carry out that which You have ordered us to do in it;

Such as the obedience to You which You have made incumbent upon us,

and accept them from us, for You are the most Generous of all those who show generosity

and the most Merciful of all those who show mercy.

Respond! Respond! O Lord of the Worlds.

General Acts for the 1st Night of the Month of Ramadhan

- It is recommended to take a Ghusl tonight.
- It is recommended to bathe oneself in a flowing river and to pour on the head thirty handfuls of water so as to be mentally pure up to the next Month of Ramadhan.
- It is recommended to visit the holy tomb of Imam al-Husayn عليه السلام so that the sins will be forgiven and the like of the reward of those who undertake the Hajj and the `Umrah in that year will be recorded for him. Recite Ziyarah.

• Recite a two Rak`ah prayer reciting in each Rak`ah Surah of *al-Fatihah* and Surah of *al-An`am* (No. 6) and pray to Almighty Allah for security against ailments.

Dua after Maghrib Prayer for the First Night of Month of Ramadhan

It is recommended to say the following supplication while raising the hands after the Maghrib Prayer. The supplication has been reported in 'al-Iqbal' from Imam Muhammad Jawad (al-Taqi) عليه السلام

<u>mp3</u>

O Allah Who controls the management of all affairs

and He has power over all things!

O He Who knows the stealth of looks,

that which breasts conceal, and that which selves hide

and He is the Knower of subtle, the Aware!

O Allah, (please do) include us with those who intend and carried out their intentions,

and do not include us with those who are unhappy due to their laziness

or with those who depend upon unreal hopes.

O Allah, (please do) cure our bodies from ailments

and help us carry out the deeds You have made incumbent upon us to do

so that when this month, which is Your month, elapses, we shall have carried out all the duties that You have made obligatory upon us to do.

O Allah, (please do) help us observe fasting in this month,

guide us to practice the acts of worship (perfectly),

grant us vigor to offer prayers,

do not preclude us from reciting (the

Holy Qur'an), وَسَهِّلْ لَنَا فِيهِ إِيتَاءَ ٱلزَّكَاةِ

and make easy for us to give alms.

O Allah, (please) do not inflict us with fatigue, tiredness,

وَل لا سَقَماً وَلا عَطَباً

ailment, or injury.

O Allah, (please do) grant us the food with which we break our fasting from Your sustenance that is legally gotten.

O Allah, (please do) make easy for us the gaining of Your sustenance that You decide for us,

facilitate for us gaining that which You decide for us,

and make it pure, empty of sins,

and free from offenses and flaws.

O Allah, (please) do not feed us except

the good that is neither bad nor forbidden.

أَسْقَامٌ

(Please do) let the sustenance that You decide for us be legal, carrying neither filth nor diseases.

O He Who knows the secret in the same was as He knows the public!

O He Who confers upon His servants with benevolence!

O He Who has power over all things

and has acquaintance with all things!

(Please do) bestow upon us with (ceaseless) reference to You,

keep us away Your difficulty,

make us obtain Your ease,

guide us to the right path,

وَوَفِّقْنَا لِلسَّدَادِ

lead us to righteousness,

وَٱعْصِمْنَا مِنَ ٱلْبَلاَيَا

protect us against misfortunes,

and safeguard us against sins and faults.

O He save Whom none forgives the grave sins

and none can relieve from hardships!

يًا أَرْحَمَ ٱلرَّاحِينَ

O most Merciful of all those who show mercy

and most Generous of all those who show generosity!

(Please do) send blessings to Muhammad and his Household the pure

and decide our fasting to be acceptable

and connected to piety and godliness.

Similarly, (please do) decide our efforts to be praiseworthy,

our acts of worship admissible,

our reciting of the Qur'an raised (to the heavens),

and our supplications responded.

(Please do) guide us to the most

excellent way,

وَجَنِّبْنَا ٱلْعُسْرَىٰ

save us from difficulties,

وَيَسِّرْنَا لِلْيُسْرَىٰ

facilitate for us the easy end,

وَأَعْلِ لَنَا ٱلدَّرَجَاتِ

elevate our ranks,

وَضَاعِفْ لَنَا ٱلْحُسَنَاتِ

double the rewards for our good deeds,

وَٱقْبَلْ مِنَّا ٱلصَّوْمَ وَٱلصَّلاَةَ

accept our fasting and prayers,

وَٱسْمَعْ مِنَّا ٱلدَّعَوَاتِ

react to our supplications,

وَٱغْفِرْ لَنَا ٱلْخَطِيئَاتِ

forgive our sins,

وَتَجَاوَزْ عَنَّا ٱلسَّيِّئَاتِ

overlook our wrongdoings,

وَٱجْعَلْنَا مِنَ ٱلْعَامِلِينَ ٱلْفَائِزِينَ

make us of the successful worshippers,

and do not include us with those who earn Your anger nor of those who go astray

حَتَّىٰ يَنْقَضِيَ شَهْرُ رَمَضَانَ عَنَّا

so that when the month of Ramadhan

elapses,

You shall have accepted our fasting and acts of worship,

blessed our deeds,

forgiven our sins,

and doubled our shares from all good things.

Verily, You are the God Who responds,

وَٱلرَّبُّ ٱلْقَرِيبُ

the Lord Who is Nigh,

and You encompass all things.

Supplication for Last Night of Sha'ban and First Night of Month of Ramadhan

Shaykh al-Tusi has narrated on the authority of Harith ibn Mughirah al-Nadhriy that Imam al-Sadiq عليه السلام used to say the following supplication at the last night of Sha`ban and the first night of the Month of Ramadhan:

<u>mp3</u>

اَللَّهُمَّ إِنَّ هٰذَا الشَّهْرَ الْمُبَارَكَ
O Allah, this blessed month
الَّذِي أُنْزِلَ فِيهِ الْقُرْآنُ

in which the Qur'an was revealed

and was made guidance for people

and clear proofs of the guidance, and the Criterion (of right and wrong),

has commenced.

So, (please) keep us out of blemish during it,

keep it sound for us,

and receive it from us with means of easiness and good health from You.

O He Who has accepted the little (deed) and thanked for the much,

(please) accept from me the little (deed).

O Allah, I beseech You

to make for me a path to every

decency, وَمِنْ كُلِّ مَا لَا تُحِبُّ مَانِعاً

and to make for me a barrier against everything that You do not like.

O most Merciful of all those who show mercy!

O He Who has pardoned me and overlooked the misdeeds that I have committed secretly!

O He Who has not punished me for my committing acts of disobedience

to Him!

I seek Your pardon, I seek Your pardon, I seek Your pardon, O All-generous!

O my God, You advised me, but I have not followed Your advice

and You rebuked me for violating that which You have deemed forbidden, but I have not stopped.

Now, what is my excuse?



So, (please) pardon me, O Allgenerous!

عَفْوَكَ عَفْوَكَ

I seek Your pardon, I seek Your pardon!

اَللَّهُمَّ إِنَّي أَسْأَلُكَ

O Allah, I beseech You

ٱلرَّاحَةَ عِنْدَ ٱلْمَوْتِ

for rest at death

وَٱلْعَفْوَ عِنْدَ ٱلْحِسَابِ

and for pardon at calling to account.

عَظْمَ ٱلذَّنْبُ مِنْ عَبْدِكَ

Great is the sin of Your servant;

so, let Your overlooking him be excellent.

O He Who is worth being feared and is worth forgiving!

I seek Your pardon, I seek Your pardon.

O Allah, I am Your servant and the

son of Your servant and Your sheservant

and I am weak and in need for Your mercy;

while You are the Pourer of wealth and bless on the servants (of You),

You are omnipotent and full of power,

You have recorded all their (i.e. Your servants) deeds,

وَقَسَمْتَ أَرْزَاقَهُمْ

decided the sustenance of each one them,

and made them of different languages and colors

in different stages of creation.

Your servants can never attain Your knowledge

and Your servants can never

recognize the real estimate that is due to You.

All of us are needy for Your mercy.

So, (please) do not turn Your Face away from me

and include me with the virtuous creatures of You

in deeds, hopes,

and Your decisions (for me).

O Allah, (please) keep me alive in the best manner of living,

decide for me to die in the best manner of death keeping loyal to Your representatives,

incurring the enmity of Your enemies,

keeping desiring for You, fearing from You,

وَٱلْخُشُوعِ وَٱلْوَفَاءِ وَٱلتَّسْلِيمِ لَكَ

and submitting to You, being loyal to You, complying with You,

believing in Your Book,

and following Your Prophet's instructions.

O Allah, as for whatever I bear in my heart,

including suspicion, doubt,

أَوْ جُحُودٍ أَوْ قُنُوطٍ

denial, despair,

أَوْ فَرَحٍ أَوْ بَذَخٍ أَوْ بَطَرٍ

(excessive) joy, lavish expenditure or recklessness,

أَوْ خُيلاءَ أَوْ رِيَاءٍ أَوْ سُمْعَةٍ

pride, arrogance, ostentation,

أَوْ شِقَاقٍ أَوْ نِفَاقٍ

discord, hypocrisy,

أَوْ كُفْرٍ أَوْ فُسُوقٍ أَوْ عِصْيَانٍ

unbelief, licentiousness, disobedience,

conceit, or anything else that You do not like;

I thus beseech You, O my Lord, to substitute all that with belief in Your promise,

fulfillment of my covenant to You,

satisfaction with what You decide for me,

وَزُهْداً فِي ٱلدُّنْيَا

indifference to the worldly pleasures,

desire for that which You have,

altruism, tranquility,

and sincere repentance.

I beseech You for all that, O Lord of the worlds!

O my God, because You are so forbearing, You are disobeyed as if You are not present,

and because You are so generous and magnanimous, You are obeyed as if You have not been disobeyed at all.

Both those who have not disobeyed You and I are the inhabitants of Your lands;

so, (please) confer magnanimously upon us with Your favors

and always refer to us with Your goodness.

O most Merciful of all those who show mercy!

May Allah bless Muhammad and his Household with endless blessings

that are innumerable, uncountable,

and none can do it save You.

يًا أَرْحَمَ ٱلرَّاحِمِينَ

Dua of Imam Ja'far Sadiq عليه السلام for the 1st Night of the Month of Ramadhan

It is recommended to say the following supplication that is reported from Imam Ja`far al-Sadiq عليه السلام as is mentioned in the book of 'al-Iqbal':

<u>mp3</u>

O Allah, the Lord of the month of Ramadhan

and the Revealer of the Qur'an.

هٰذَا شَهْرُ رَمَضَانَ

This is the month of Ramadhan

in which You revealed the Qur'an

and revealed therein chapters of true guidance and distinction (between the right and the wrong).

O Allah, make us observe fast in its days

and remain awake in its nights to pray.

اَللَّهُمَّ سَلِّمْهُ لَنَا

O Allah, let it be peaceful for us,

keep us in sound condition for it,

and receive it from us with easiness and wellbeing.

While taking decisions

from among Your inevitable decisions

and from among that which You decide from the wise affairs

at the Destiny Night

from the act that is neither rejected nor altered,

(please) write my name in the list of those pilgrims to Your Sacred House

whose pilgrimage receives Your approval,

whose efforts are appreciated,

whose sins are forgiven,

and whose wrongdoings are overlooked.

While making decisions and rendering possible things and events,

(please) grant me long lifetime

وَتُوسِّعَ عَلَيَّ مِنَ ٱلرِّزْقِ ٱلْحُلاَلِ

and expand my sustenance, making it from legal sources only.

Dua to Welcome the Month of Ramadhan from Sahifa Sajjadiyah

It is recommended to say the supplication number forty-four of the *al-Sahifah al-Kamilah al-Sajjadiyyah*, which is as follows:

<u>mp3</u>

Praise belongs to Allah who guided us to His praise

and placed us among the people of praise,

لِنَكُوْنَ لِإِحْسَانِهِ مِنَ الشَّاكِرِيْنَ

that we might be among the thankful for His beneficence

and that He might recompense us for that with the recompense of the good-doers!

And praise belongs to Allah who

showed favour to us through His religion,

singled us out for His creed,

and directed us onto the roads of His beneficence,

in order that through His kindness we might travel upon them to His good pleasure,

a praise which He will accept from us and through which He will be pleased with us!

وَالْحُمَدُ لِلَّهِ الَّذِيْ جَعَلَ مِنْ تِلْكَ السُّبُلِ

شُهْرَه

And praise belongs to Allah who appointed among those roads His month,

شَهْرَ رَمَضَانَ

the month of Ramazan,

شَهْرَ الصِّيامِ

the month of fasting,

وَ شَهْرَ الْإِسْلَامِ

the month of submission,

وَ شَهْرَ الطُّهُوْرِ

the month of purity,

the month of putting to test,

the month of standing in prayer,

in which the Qur'an was sent down as guidance to the people, and as clear signs of the Guidance and the Separator!

He clarified its excellence over other months by the

مِنَ الْخُرُمَاتِ الْمَوْفُوْرَةِ

many sacred things and

well-known excellencies which He placed therein,

for He made unlawful in it what He declared lawful in others to magnify it,

He prohibited foods and drinks in it to honour it,

and He appointed for it a clear time

which He (majestic and mighty is He) allows not to be set forward

and accepts not to be placed behind.

Then He made one of its nights surpass the nights of a thousand months and named it

the Night of Decree;

in it the angels and the Spirit descend by the leave of their Lord upon every command,

a peace constant in blessings until the rising of the dawn upon whomsoever He will of His servants according to the decision He has made firm.

O Allah, bless Muhammad and his Household,

وَ اَلْمِمْنَا

inspire us with

مَعْرِفَةً فَضْلِهِ

knowledge of its excellence,

وَ إِجْلَالَ خُرْمَتِهِ

veneration of its inviolability,

وَالتَّحَفُّظَ مِمَّا حَظَرْتَ فِيْهِ

and caution against what Thou hast forbidden within it,

وَ أَعِنَّا عَلَى صِيَامِهِ بِكُفِّ الْجُوَارِحِ عَنْ مَعَاصِيْكَ وَاسْتِعْمَالِهَا فِيْهِ بِمَا يُرْضِيْكَ حَتَّى مَعَاصِيْكَ وَاسْتِعْمَالِهَا فِيْهِ بِمَا يُرْضِيْكَ حَتَّى

and help us to fast in it by our restraining our limbs from acts of disobedience toward Thee and our employing them in that which pleases

Thee, so that

لَا نُصْغِى بِأَسْمَاعِنَا إِلَى لَغْوِ

we lend not our ears to idle talk

وَ لَا نُسْرِعَ بِأَبْصَارِنَا اللَّي لَمُو

and hurry not with our eyes to diversion,

we stretch not our hands toward the forbidden

and stride not with our feet toward the prohibited,

our bellies hold only what Thou hast made lawful

and our tongues speak only what Thou hast exemplified,

we undertake nothing but what brings close to Thy reward

وَ لَا نَتَعَاطَى اللَّ الَّذِيْ مِنْ عِقَابِكَ

and pursue nothing but what protects from Thy punishment!

Then rid all of that from

the false show of the false showers

and the fame seeking of the fame seekers,

lest we associate therein anything with Thee

وَ لَا نَبْتَغِيْ بِهِ مُرَادًا سِوَاكَ

or seek therein any object of desire but Thee!

O Allah, bless Muhammad and his Household,

in it make us attend to the appointed moments of the five prayers within

the bounds Thou hast set,

the obligations Thou hast decreed,

وَ وَظَائِفِهَا الَّتِيْ وَظَّفْتَ

the duties Thou hast assigned,

وَ أَوْقَاهِا الَّتِيْ وَقَّتَّ

and the times Thou hast specified;

and in the prayers make us alight in the station of

الْمُصِيْبِيْنَ لِمَنَازِلِمَا

the keepers of their stations,

the guardians of their pillars,

their performers in their times,

as Thy servant and Thy messenger set down in his Sunna (Thy blessings be upon him and his Household) in their bowings, their prostrations, and all their excellent acts,

with the most complete and ample ritual purity

and the most evident and intense humility!

وَ وَفِقْنَا فِيْهِ

Give us success in this month to

tighten our bonds of kin with devotion and gifts,

attend to our neighbours with bestowal and giving,

rid our possessions from claims,

purify them through paying the alms,

وَ أَنْ نُرَاجِعَ مَنْ هَاجَرَنَا

go back to him who has gone far from us,

treat justly him who has wronged us,

make peace with him who shows enmity toward us

(except him who is regarded as an enemy in Thee and for Thee, for he is

the enemy whom we will not befriend,

وَ الْحِزْبُ الَّذِيْ لَا نُصَافِيْهِ

the party whom we will not hold dear), وَ اَنْ نَتَقَرَّبَ اِلَيْكَ فِيْهِ مِنَ الْأَعْمَالِ الزَّاكِيَةِ

عِا تُطَهِّرُنَا بِهِ مِنَ الذُّنُوْبِ

and seek nearness to Thee through blameless works which will purify us from sins

وَ تَعْصِمَنَا فِيْهِ مِمَّا نَسْتَاْنِفُ مِنَ الْعُيُوْبِ and preserve us from renewing faults, حَتَّى لَا يُوْرِدَ عَلَيْكَ اَحَدٌ مِنْ مَلَائِكَتِكَ الآ كُوْرِدَ عَلَيْكَ اَحَدٌ مِنْ مَلَائِكَتِكَ الآ

so that none of Thy angels will bring for Thee

أَبْوَابِ الطَّاعَةِ لَكَ

the kinds of obedience and

وَ أَنْوَاعِ الْقُرْبَةِ اللَّك

sorts of nearness-seeking unless they be less than what we bring! 2451

اَللَّهُمَّ اِبِّي اَسْالُكَ

O Allah, I ask Thee

بِحَقِّ هٰذَا الشَّهْرِ

by the right of this month

وَ جِحَقٍّ مَنْ تَعَبَّدَ لَكَ فِيْهِ

and by the right of him who worships
Thee within it

from its beginning to the time of its passing,

whether angel Thou hast brought nigh to Thee,

prophet Thou hast sent,

or righteous servant Thou hast singled out,

أَنْ تُصَلِّي عَلَى مُحَمَّدٍ وَآلِهِ

This is an excerpt from the book Spiritual Journey of the Mystics (Saluk-e-Arifan) - which is the translation of Arabic book: al-Muraqebat fi Amal al-Sunnah, written by the most eminent perfect mystic Late Haj Mirza Javad Agha Maliki Tabrizi;

Another thing which a prudent wayfarer should not forget during the first night of this holy month is resorting (Tawassul) to the impeccable ones (Ma'sumin) in that night. It is up to him to stretch his hand sincerely

towards the threshold of those exalted saintly personalities by offering salutations and thanks should open our tongues for needs, and saying the following sincerely and honestly:

O' my masters! Tonight you are the support and shelter of everyone

you are the most exalted and generous among all exalted and generous ones, you like inviting guests and want to be generous towards them

ومأمور من الله جل جلاله بالإجارة ، عبدك ضيف الله وضيفك ، وجار الله وجارك

Allah (the Glorious, the Exalted), has commanded you to provide refuge and shelter for the wretched and unsheltered people

now here is one of the Allah's unsheltered servants who has came to attend your as well as Allah's feast has attached his heart upon your support and well as Allah's support and hospitality

be hospitable and allow him to sit upon the table of your generosity and treat him in the following manner:

Consider him as your friend and supporter and do not deprive him from your best support and endeavors; do not deprive him from your prayer, backing, and intercession

ask Allah (the Glorious, the Exalted), not to deprive him from His Forgiveness and Benevolence; shouldn't deprive him from His mercy and compassion

you are the ones who never returned any one hopeless and empty-handed

do not deprive me from the rain of your generosity

saturate me with the rain of your generosity,

(do not deprive me from the pouring of your love) because I am thirsty for your

generosity and hungry for your love and affection;

you don't like that your guests who have taken shelter in your threshold and have tied their hopes upon your benevolence should remain thirsty and hungry.

Dua before Reciting the Holy Qur'an

It is highly advisable to recite the Holy Qur'an very frequently at the first hours of the Month of Ramadhan. In this respect, it has been narrated that Imam Ja`far al-Sadiq عليه السلام used to say the following supplication before he would start reciting the Holy Qur'an:

Dua after Reciting the Holy Qur'an

When he finished reciting the Holy Qur'an, Imam al-Sadiq عليه السلام used to say the following supplication:

(Please) include me with those whom You raise a rank to the most elevated position with each verse that they recite.

Respond to me, O Lord of the worlds!

General Acts for the First Day of the Holy Month of Ramadhan

Take a Ghusl in flowing water and to pour on the head thirty handfuls of water, for such a deed brings about security against all pains and ailments up to the next year.

It is recommended to wash one's face with a handful of rose water so as to be saved against humiliation and poverty, and to pour some of it on the head so as to be saved from pleurisy.

It is recommended to offer the first of the month prayer that consists of two Rak`ahs and to give alms (sadqa) after it.

It is recommended to offer a prayer of two Rak`ahs at the first of which Surah of *al-Fatihah* and Surah of *al-Fath* (No. 48) should be recited and at the second Rak`ah, Surah of *al-Fatihah* and any other Surah should be reicted. If one offers this prayer, Almighty Allah will save him from all evils and will keep him under His custody up to the next year.

Supplication at Dawn on the First Day of the Month of Ramadhan

When the dawn breaks forth, it is recommended to say the following supplication:

<u>mp3</u>

O Allah, the month of Ramadhan has commenced.

You have made obligatory upon us to observe fasting during it.

You revealed the Qur'an in it

هُدَىً لِلنَّاسِ وَبَيِّنَاتٍ مِنَ ٱلْهُدَىٰ وَٱلْفُرْقَانِ

as guidance for people and clear proofs of true guidance and distinction (between the right and the wrong).

O Allah, (please) help us observe fasting in it,

accept it from us,

receive it from us (with acceptance),

and keep it sound for us with easiness

and good health from You.

You verily have power over all things.

Dua of Imam Musa Kadhim عليه السلام for the First Day of the Month of Ramadhan

In his book of 'Zad al-Ma'ad', 'Allamah al-Majlisiy has mentioned that al-Kulayniy, al-Tusiy, and others, through an authentic series of narrators, have reported Imam Musa al-Ka¨im عليه السلام as saying, "Say the following supplication in the month of Ramadhan—on the first day of it, as is understood by scholars for if one prays Almighty Allah with this supplication purely and without associating any false purposes showing off, he will be saved, throughout that year, from all seditious and

misleading matters as well as all afflictions that may injure his religion or his body; and Almighty Allah will save him from the evils of all the misfortunes that will occur in that year." The supplication is as follows:
