

Common Taqibaat of Daily Prayers from Mafatih & Baqiyatus salehat

To sit and recite the Holy Quran, or dua'as, narrated by the Holy Ahlul Bayt, after the obligatory Salaat, is called "Taa'-qeeb", the literal meaning of which is "delay. It is "Sunnat I-Muwakkidah" (strongly recommended) to recite "Taa'-qeebaat" after every obligatory salaat

a) Imam Mohammed Baqir (a.s.) has said that after every mandatory prayer, there is no better invocation than the **Tasbeeh e Fatima (a.s.)**. If there was any other, more effective, way of Praising Allah, the Prophet (a.s.) would most certainly have instructed his daughter about that. Imam Jafar e Sadiq has said that reciting the Tasbeeh e Fatima (a.s.) after every compulsory prayer is better than performing a thousand genuflections :- **Allaho Akbar** (34 times) **Alhamdu lillah** (33 times) **Subhan Allah** (33 times)

b) One should say once after reciting the Tasbeeh ,the following words **La ilaha ilAllah** لَا إِلَهَ إِلَّا اللَّهُ

c) Imam Baqir (a.s.) says One who sits quietly after each mandatory prayer and recites 3 times the following , Allah will pardon all his sins:

I seek forgiveness from the Lord (testifying) There is no God other than Him The Living and the Everlasting Of Majesty and Splendour And I turn to Him In Repentance

CHAPTER ONE Mafatih GENERAL POST-PRAYER duas

The following prayers and recommended devotional acts have been quoted from [Shaykh al-Tūsī's](#) famous book of *Miṣbāh al-Mutahajjid* and other reference books.

After you say the *Taslim* statement—the closing part of the ritual prayers—and accomplish your prayer, repeat the Takbir statement (i.e. *allāhu akbar*; Allah is the Greatest) three times while raising your hands to the level of your ears and then say: [Use this Transliteration font](#) [MP3](#)

Then, utter the Tasbīḥ al-Zahrā' litany (which is discussed in the attached book of *al-Bāqiyāt al-Sāliḥāt*).
Before you move from your prayer-place, repeat the following litany ten times:

I bear witness that there is no god save Allah;

ash-hadu an lā ilāha illā allāhu

(He is) One and Only; and there is no partner with Him;

waḥdahū lā sharīka lahū

a Single God;

ilāhan wāḥidan

One, Unique, and eternally Besought of all.

aḥadan fardan ṣamadān

He has taken to Himself neither a wife nor a son.

lam yattakhidh ṣāḥibatan wa lā waladan

It is narrated that a great reward is obtained by saying this litany, especially after the Dawn (Fajr) and Evening (`Ishā') obligatory Prayers and at sunrise and sunset.
Then, say the following:

Then, recite the following Qur'ānic texts:

(1) Sūrah al-Hamd (i.e. al-Fātiḥah No. 1), (2) Āyah al-Kursī (2:255-257), (3) Verses of Bearing Witness (Āyat al-Shahādah; 3:18-19), (4) Verses of Kingdom (Āyah al-Mulk; 3:26-27), and (5) Verses of Subservience (Āyah al-Sakharah 7:54-56).

Then, repeat the following verses (Sūrah al-Sāffāt 37:180-183) three times:

Glory be to your Lord, the Lord of Honor, above what they describe.

subhāna rabbika rabbi al-`izzati `ammā yaṣifūna

سُبْحَانَ رَبِّكَ رَبِّ الْعِزَّةِ عَمَّا يَصِفُونَ

And peace be on the messengers.

wa salāmun `alā almursalīna

وَسَلَامٌ عَلَى الْمُرْسَلِينَ

And all praise is due to Allah, the Lord of the worlds.

walḥamdu lillāhi rabbi al-`ālamīna

وَالْحَمْدُ لِلَّهِ رَبِّ الْعَالَمِينَ.

Then, repeat the following prayer three times:

O Allah, (Please) send blessings to Muḥammad and the Household of Muḥammad,

allāhumma ṣalli `alā muḥammadin wa āli muḥammadin

اللَّهُمَّ صَلِّ عَلَيَّ مُحَمَّدٍ وَآلِ مُحَمَّدٍ

cause all my affairs to arrive at a relief, prepare for me a way out,

waj`al lī min amri farajan wa makhrajan

وَأَجْعَلْ لِي مِنْ مَرِيئِي فَرَجًا وَمَخْرَجًا

and give me sustenance from whence I think and from whence I do not think.

warzuqni min ḥaythu aḥtasibu wa min ḥaythu lā aḥtasibu

وَارْزُقْنِي مِنْ حَيْثُ حَتَسِبُ وَمِنْ حَيْثُ لَا

حَتَسِبُ

This prayer was taught by Archangel Gabriel to Prophet Yūsuf (Joseph)—peace be upon him—when he was in prison.

Then, hold your beard with your right hand, raise your left hand towards the sky, and repeat the following prayer seven times:

O Lord of Muḥammad and the Household of Muḥammad:

yārabba muḥammadin wa āli muḥammadin

يَا رَبَّ مُحَمَّدٍ وَآلِ مُحَمَّدٍ

(Please) send blessings to Muḥammad and the Household of Muḥammad

salli `alā muḥammadin wa `āli muḥammadin

صَلِّ عَلَى مُحَمَّدٍ وَآلِ مُحَمَّدٍ

and hasten the Relief of the Household of Muḥammad. wa `ajjil faraja `āli muḥammadin

وَعَجِّلْ فَرَجَ آلِ مُحَمَّدٍ

Keeping on the same situation, repeat the following prayer three times:

O Lord of Majesty and Honor,

yā dhaljalāli wal-ikrāmi

يَا ذَا الْجَلَالِ وَالْإِكْرَامِ

(Please) send blessings to Muḥammad and the Household of Muḥammad

salli `alā muḥammadin wa `āli muḥammadin

صَلِّ عَلَى مُحَمَّدٍ وَآلِ مُحَمَّدٍ

have mercy upon me, and deliver me from Hellfire.

warḥamni wa ajjirni mina alnnāri

وَارْحَمْنِي وَجِرْنِي مِنَ النَّارِ

After repeating Sūrah al-Ikhlāṣ (or *al-Tawḥīd*; No. 112) twelve times, say the following prayer:

O Allah, I beseech You in Your Name: the well-guarded, stored,

allāhumma inni as'aluka bismika almaknūni almakhzūni

اللَّهُمَّ إِنِّي سَأَلْتُكَ بِاسْمِكَ الْمَكْنُونِ الْمَخْزُونِ

pure, immaculate, and blessed.

alttāhiri alttuhri almubāraki

الطَّاهِرِ الطُّهْرِ الْمُبَارَكِ

And I beseech You in Your Great Name

wa as'aluka bismika al`azīmi

وَسَأَلْتُكَ بِاسْمِكَ الْعَظِيمِ

and Your eternal power.

wa sulṭānika alqadīmi

وَسُلْطَانِكَ الْقَدِيمِ

O Donor of gifts!

yā wāhibā al`aṭāyā

يَا وَاهِبِ الْعَطَايَا

O Releaser of captives!

wa yā muṭliqa al-usārā

وَيَا مُطْلِقَ الْأَسْرَى

O Deliverer of necks from the Fire!

wa yā fakkāka alrriqābi mina alnnāri

وَيَا فَكَّاكَ الرِّقَابِ مِنَ النَّارِ

I beseech You to send blessings to Muḥammad and the Household of Muḥammad,

as'aluka an tuṣalliya `alā muḥammadin wa `āli muḥammadin

سَأَلْتُكَ أَنْ تُصَلِّيَ عَلَيَّ مُحَمَّدٍ وَآلِ مُحَمَّدٍ

to deliver me from the Fire,

wa an tu`tiqa raqabatī mina alnnāri

وَأَنْ تُعْتِقَ رَقَبَتِي مِنَ النَّارِ

to cause me leave this world free (from liabilities),

wa an tukhrijāni mina alddunyā sāliman

وَأَنْ تُخْرِجَنِي مِنَ الدُّنْيَا سَالِمًا

to allow me to Paradise with security,

wa tudkhlāni aljannata āminan

وَتُدْخِلَنِي الْجَنَّةَ آمِنًا

and to make the beginning of my prayer successful,

wa an taj`ala du`āi awwalahū falāḥan

وَأَنْ تَجْعَلَ دُعَائِي وَوَلَّهُ فَلَاحًا

the middle of it a gain,

wa awsaṭahū najāḥan

وَأَوْسَطَهُ نَجَاحًا

and the end of it a prosperity.

wa ākhirahū ṣalāḥan

وَأَخِيرَهُ صَلَاحًا

Verily, You are the Knower of all unseen things.

innaka anta `allāmu alghuyūbi

According to *al-Sahīfah al-`Alawīyyah* (a collection of Imam `Alī's supplications), the following prayer is advisably said after the obligatory prayers:

O He Who is not distracted by a sound from hearing another sound!

yā man lā yashghaluhū sam`un `an sam`in

يَا مَنْ لَا يَشْغَلُهُ سَمْعٌ عَنْ سَمْعٍ

O He Who is not confused by the beseechers!

wa yā man lā yughallituhū alssā'ilūna

وَيَا مَنْ لَا يَغْلُطُهُ السَّائِلُونَ

O He Who is not annoyed by the insistence of those who entreat Him persistently!

wa yā man lā yubrimuhū ilhāḥu almuliḥḥina

وَيَا مَنْ لَا يُبْرِمُهُ الْإِحَاحُ الْمُلِحِّينَ

(Please do) Make me taste the nice flavor of Your pardon

adhīqni barda `afwika

ذُقْنِي بَرْدَ عَفْوِكَ

and the sweetness of Your mercy and forgiveness.

wa ḥalāwata raḥmatika wa maghfiratika

وَحَلَاوَةَ رَحْمَتِكَ وَمَغْفِرَتِكَ

You may also say the following prayer:

O Allah, This is my prayer that I have just offered

ilāhī hādhihī ṣalāti ṣallaytuhā

إِلَهِي هَذِهِ صَلَاتِي صَلَّيْتُهَا

on account of neither a need that You may have for it

lā liḥājatin minka ilayhā

CHAPTER FOUR SUPPLICATIONS BEFORE AND AFTER RITUAL PRAYERS (BAQIYATUS SALEHAT)

Five in number, these prayers are as follows:

First: Imam al-Sādiq (`a) is reported to have said: Imam `Ali Amīr al-Mu`minīn (`a) used to say: Whoever says these words, will be added to the group of Muḥammad and Household:

Before commencing a ritual prayer, the following prayer may be said:

Second: Safwān al-Jammāl is reported to have said: I was once with Imam al-Ṣādiq (`a). He directed his face towards the kiblah direction (for performing a prayer) and said following prayer before he uttered the *takbīrah al-iḥrām* statement (i.e. the commencing statement of the ritual prayers):

O Allah, (please) do not make me despair of Your soothing mercy,

allāhumma lā tu'yisnī min rawḥika

do not make me lose hope of Your mercy,

Peace be on Hujjat son of Hasan, Al Qaaim, Al Mahdi, the living, the rightly guided. Blessings on all of them.

(6) Recite 10 times (Particularly after Fajr and Maghrib prayers):

(i) I bear witness that witness that there is no God save Allah, alone, He has no partner, Lord God, Unique, One, Single, the eternally Besought of all. He has chosen no consort, nor has He any son.

(All) praise is for Allah, as often as and each time when something praises Allah, and just as loves Allah that which praises Him with (the words) "Alhamduillillah" as He (alone) is fit for and is worthy of, since it is for the sake of His kind disposition, and glory of His Majesty. There is no God save Allah, as often as and each time when something cries out "Allah" in joy and delight, and just as loves Allah that which pronounces the words "Laa ilaaha ilallah" as He (alone) is fit for and is worthy of, since it is for the sake of His kind disposition, and glory of His Majesty. Allah is the Greatest, as often as and each time when something calls Allah Great and sublime, and just as loves Allah that which says "Allahu Akbar" as He (alone) is fit for and is worthy of, since it is for the sake of His kind disposition, and glory of His Majesty. "Glory be to Allah", (All) praise is for Allah (alone) "there is God save Allah", and "Allah is the Greatest", for all the bounties bestowed upon me, and on every one of the created beings that He created, by whom (the above noted four declarations) used to be, are, or shall be made to the Last Day of Judgment. O My Allah send blessings on Muhammad and on the Children of Muhammad. I request Thee (to give me) the good that I ask for, and the good which I have not referred to. I take refuge with Thee, from the evil that is hanging over my head, and the evil which has not yet come upon me.

Verily your Lord is Allah who created the earth in six days; then occupied the throne (Arsh). He covers the night with the day which swiftly follows it, and has made the sun and the moon and the stars subservient by His command. Verily His is all creation and commandment. Blessed is Allah, the Lord of the Worlds. Call upon your Lord humbly and in secret. Verily He loves not the transgressors. And make not mischief in the earth after it's "fair ordering" (Reformation) thereof, and call on Him in awe and hope. Verily the mercy of Allah is at hand for those who do good.

(ii) And the following dua'a Imam Ali Al-Murtaza(A.S.) used to recite 12times after every obligatory Namaaz.

O My Allah, I beseech Thee in the name of Thy well-guarded, treasured, pure, chaste, and blessed name; and I beseech Thee in the name of Thy Great name, Thy Kingdom is eternal, O He who makes many generous presents, O He who sets slaves free, O He who loses and unties the throttling ties around the neck in the fire of Hell, I beseech Thee (that) Thou send blessings on Muhammad and on the Children of Muhammad, and set my neck free from the burning inferno; make my exit from this world calm and peaceful, and my entry in Paradise safe and easy, settle my supplication (as under) :

Let the first be a total liberation, the middle a whole success, let the last be a beautiful order of lasting peace. Verily Thou art well aware of all that is hidden and invisible.

(11) (then) Recite :

[Imam Ali Al-Murtaza (A.S.) had advised his followers to recite the following dua'as after every obligatory Namaaz]

(i) O He whom hearing of one sound does not render inattentive to the other, O He whom supplicants (how many they may be) do not confuse or disturb, O He whom clamorous determined pleading of petitioners do not upset; let me cultivate the good taste of enjoying the calm and quiet, only Thy favours make possible; the gentleness and unselfishness Thy kindness and indulgence develop (in me).

(ii)

My Allah, the Salaat (Namaaz) I have just prayed, was not to put forth any demand before Thee, nor was there any self-seeking desire to reach Thee through it. It was nothing but praise, obedience and surrender unto Thee, in order to carry out that which Thou has commanded. My Allah, If there was a break of continuity (disturbance of mind) or shortcoming, while making the intention, or standing, while bowing down, or prostrating in adoration, do not catch hold of me, (but) have the kindness of bestowing a favour on me, by affording me through Thy mercy absolution and acceptance, O the Most Merciful.

(iii) The following dua'a was taught by the Holy Prophet (S.A.) to Imam Ali (A.S.), to be recited after every obligatory Salaat, for developing a flawless memory:

Glory be to Him who does not treat the citizens of His Kingdom unjustly and harshly, Glory be to Him who does not let torment and pain come suddenly upon mankind, Glory be to the Compassionate, the Merciful. O Allah fill my heart and mind with true enlightenment, discerning intelligence, quick understanding and knowledge, Verily Thou art able to do all things.

(12) In "Misbah of Kafa'amee" it is written that the following dua'a may be recited after every obligatory Salaat :

Long for Thy protection my Nafs (soul), my belief, my family, my possessions, my children and my brother's-in-faith, and that which Thou, my Lord gives me as means of livelihood, and my deeds that have been done, and whoso makes know and refers to his cause and case in the name of Allah, and no other, the Single, the Independent Everlasting, (who) begets not, nor was begotten, and there is none like (comparable) unto Him; (in the name of) the Lord of daybreak, from the evil of that which He has created; from the evil of the darkness when it is intense, and from the evil of the malignant witchcraft, and from the evil of the envier when he envies. (in the name of) the Lord of mankind, the King of mankind, the God of mankind, from the evil of the sneaking whisperer, who whispers in the hearts of people, (be he) from among the jinn and mankind

(13) Recite the following dua'a after every obligatory prayer:

It is reported that the Holy Prophet (S.A.) had said that if one wants to keep hidden (forgiven) his faults and mistakes, committed in this world, on the Day of Judgment, he should recite the following dua'a after every obligatory prayer:

My Allah, indeed, Thy indulgence is more to be hoped for than my deeds; certainly Thy mercy is more deep and far-reaching compared to my faults and mistakes. My Allah if my errors, in the matter of Thy laws, are grave in nature, Thy pardon is more substantial and well-known than my transgressions. If not obscured the befitting (praise), that eloquently describes Thy Mercy to perfection, it is because Thy Mercy is most (praise) worthy, (which) obtains and speeds up plenty of opportunities for me in everything, through Thy kindness O the Most Merciful.
