

Imam Ja`far al Sadiq (a) is also reported to have said that one who desires to enjoy both the worldly life and the Next World, and one who has eye ache, should utter the following prayer after the Dawn and Sunset Prayers:

O Allah, I do beseech You, in the name of the right of Muḥammad and the Household of Muḥammad that is incumbent upon You to send blessings to Muḥammad and the Household of Muḥammad

allāhumma innī as'aluka biḥaqqi muḥammadin wa āli muḥammadin `alayka

اللَّهُمَّ إِنِّي أَسْأَلُكَ بِحَقِّ مُحَمَّدٍ  
وَأَلِ مُحَمَّدٍ عَلَيْكَ

and to make light in my sight,

ṣalli `alā muḥammadin wa āli muḥammadin

صَلِّ عَلَى مُحَمَّدٍ وَأَلِ مُحَمَّدٍ

discerning in my religion,

waj`al alnnūra fī baṣarī

وَأَجْعَلِ النُّورَ فِي بَصْرِي

conviction in my heart,

walbaṣīrata fī dīnī

وَأَلْبَصِيرَةَ فِي دِينِي

sincerity in my deeds,

wal-yaqīna fī qalbī

وَأَلْيَقِينَ فِي قَلْبِي

safety in my self,

wal-ikhhlāṣa fī `amalī

وَالْإِخْلَاصَ فِي عَمَلِي

richness in my sustenance,

walssalāmata fī nafsī

وَالسَّلَامَةَ فِي نَفْسِي

and perpetual thankfulness for You as long as you keep me alive.

walssa`ata fī rizqī

وَالسَّعَةَ فِي رِزْقِي

walshshukra laka abadan mā abqaytanī

وَالشُّكْرَ لَكَ أَبَدًا مَا أَبْقَيْتَنِي
