

Traditions highly recommend **not to delay** performing the magrib prayer & to recite it at its earliest time

Between Adhan and Iqamah, you may say the following

O Allah, I beseech You in the name
of the coming of Your night,
the departure of Your daylight,
the presence of Your prayers,
the voices of Your supplicants,
and the glorification of Your angels,
to send blessings upon Muhammad
and the Household of Muhammad
and to accept my repentance.
You are verily, the Oft-Returning,
the Most Merciful.

1. Dua after magrib 1

O Allah! I beseech You for the
motives of Your mercy,
the determining causes of Your
forgiveness,
deliverance from Hellfire
and all misfortunes,
winning Paradise,
Divine Contentment in the Abode
of Peace,
and the vicinity of Your Prophet
Muhammad—peace be upon him
and his Household.
O Allah, You are certainly the
source of each and every favor
that covers us.
There is no god save You.
I pray Your forgiveness and I
repent before You.

2. Imam Moosa alKazim (a.s) narrates that, without talking to anyone, say the following 7 times (100 times as per some narration):

In the Name of Allah; the All-
beneficent, the All-merciful. There is
neither might nor power except with
Allah, the All-high, the All-great.

*Bismillahir Rahmaan ir Raheem la
hau la quwwata illa billahil ali il
azeem*

Recite 3 times:

All praise be to Allah Who
does whatever He
wills/desires,
and none else can ever do
whatever one desires save
Him.

وَلَا يَفْعَلُ مَا يَشَاءُ غَيْرُهُ

Then, say the following prayer:

All glory be to You. There is no
god save You.
Forgive my sins all in all,
for none can forgive all sins
save You.

fa'innahū lā yaghfiru
aldhdhunūba kullahā jamī`an
illā anta

3. It is narrated from Ameer al Momineen (a.s.) that anyone who recites the **following verse three times** at the time of Maghrib prayer, till the next morning he will not suffer any loss and he will be safe from natural calamities: 30:17/18

Therefore glory be to Allah when you enter upon the time of the evening and when you enter upon the time of the morning.

And to Him belongs praise in the heavens and the earth, and at nightfall and when you are at midday.

4. Recite :

“Surely, Allah and His angels bless the Prophet.

inna allāha wa malā'ikatahū
yuṣallūna `alāalnnabiyyi

O you who believe! Call for Divine blessings on him and salute him with a becoming salutation.”

yā ayyuhā alladhīna āmanū
ṣallū `alayhi wa sallimū
taslīman

O Allah, send blessings to Muḥammad the Prophet,

allāhumma ṣalli
`alā muḥammadin alnnabiyyi

upon his offspring,

wa `alā dhurriyyatihi

and upon his Household.

wa `alā ahli baytihi

(إِنَّ اللَّهَ وَمَلَائِكَتَهُ يُصَلُّونَ عَلَى النَّبِيِّ

يَا أَيُّهَا الَّذِينَ آمَنُوا صَلُّوا عَلَيْهِ وَسَلِّمُوا
تَسْلِيمًا)

5 .Recite ALLAAHUMMA AJIRNA MINAN NAARI SAALIMEENA WA ADKHILNAL JANNATA BISALAAMIN AAMINEENA WA TAWAFFANAA MUSLIMEENA WA ALH'IQNAA BIS' S'AALIH'EENA WA S'ALLALLHU A'LAA MUH'AMMADIN WA AALIHEE AJMA-E'ENA BIFAZ'LIKA WA RAH'MATIKA YAA ARH'AMAR RAAH'IMEEN -"O Allah help us to depart from life of this world in safety and save us from fire and make us enter Paradise with peace and safety. And make us die in Thy submission and include us with the righteous, I beseech You by Thy grace and mercy on us, Oh Most Merciful of the Merciful! "

6.Then recite:“Oh Allah! Who transforms hearts and eyes, steadfast in Thy religion. And deviate not my heart after Thou hast guided me aright and bless me from Thy mercy. Surely Thou art the Most generous Giver, and by Thy mercy protect me from the fire. Oh Allah! extend the span of my life and increase my subsistence and spread Thy mercy on me; and, if in Thy Knowledge, there is anything unhappy for me in the guarded tablets change it into happiness, for surely Thou changeth what Thou pleaseth and inscribe what Thou pleaseth; and the guarded Tablet belongs Thee alone”.

7 Recite 100 times or 10 times **LAA ILAAHA ILLALLAAH** [There is no god save Allah.]

8. Recite [Surah al Waaqi-a'h.](#)

9.Recite [Ghufaylah Salat](#) **between Magrib & Isha** (this can be a part ie 1X2 of Magrib Nafilah)

10. Recite 4 Rak'ats **Nafilah (2X2)** for Maghrib four units of prayer, each two separated by a Taslīm statement. You should not utter any word between the two parts of the prayer.

You may then do the Thanksgiving prostration & recite

Thanks, thanks, thanks.

Al-Kulayni has reported Imam alSadiq (` a) as saying: When you finish the nafila sunset prayer, you may pass your hand over your forehead and repeat the following times:

In the Name of Allah save Whom there is no god, the Knower of the unseen and the seen, the All-beneficent, and the All-merciful.

alrraḥmānu alrraḥīmu

O Allah, (please) take away from me grief and distress.
