In the Name of Allah; the All-beneficent, the All-merciful.

O He Whom alone I hope for all good things;

ya man arjuhu likulli khayrin,

And I am safe from His anger at every evil.

wa amanu sakhatahu `inda kulli sharrin,

O He who gives a lot in exchange of a little.

ya man yu`ty alkathira bilqalili,

O He who gives to one who asks Him.

ya man yu`ty man salahu,

O He who gives to one who does not ask Him and does not know Him, Out of His affection .and mercy

ya man yu`ty man lam yasalhu wa man lam ya`rifhu tahannan minhu wa rahmatan,

Give me, for my request is only to You alone, All the good of this world

a`tiny bimasalaty iyyaka jami`a khayri alddunya

and all the good of the Hereafter.

wa jami`a khayri alakhirati,

Keep away from me, for my request is only to You alone, All the evil of this world and the evil of the Hereafter.

wasrif`anni bimasalaty iyyaka jami`a sharr alddunya wa sharr alakhirati,

For indeed it is not diminishing what is given by You.

fa`innhu ghayru manqusin ma a`tayta,

Increase (for) me from Your bounty, O The Generous

wa zidny min fazlika yakarimu.

ya dhal-manni wal-tawli

يَا ذَا الْمَنِّ وَالطَّوْلِ،

Save my grey hairs of the beard from the fire (of Hell)

harrim shaybaty `ala alnna

حَرِّمْ شَيْبَتِي عَلَى النَّارِ.
