

Duas when leaving home www.Duas.org

These are eight prayers to be said before one leaves his house: from Baqiyatus salehat

First: Imam al-Ṣādig (`a) is reported to have said: Repeat the following three times:

Allah is the Most Great.

allāhu akbaru

I leave (putting my trust) in Allah,

billāhi akhruju

I return (putting my trust) in Allah,

wa billāhi adkhulu

and on Allah do I depend.

wa `alā allāhi atawakkalu

يٰ ٱللَّه اتَوَكَّلُ

Then, say the following statement, yet **one time** only:

O Allah, (please) grant me easiness in the beginning of this affair of mine,

allāhumma iftah lī fī wajhī

hādhā bikhayrin

هُمَّ ٱفْتَحْ لَى فَى وَجْهِي هٰذَا بِخ

seal it for me with easiness,

wakhtim lī bikhayrin

أختم لي بخير

and guard me against the evil of every living creature that You hold by its forelock.

wa qini sharra kulli dabbatin anta ākhidun bināşiyatihā

Surely, my Lord is on the right path.

inna rabbī `alā şirāţin mustaqīmin

إن ربي على صراط مستق

Second: Imam al-Sajjād (`a) is reported to have said: At the door of your house you may say the following words:

In the Name of Allah (I begin) and in

Allah (I trust).

bismillāhi wa billāhi

بسم ٱللّه وَبِٱللّه

I put my trust in Allah.

tawkkaltu `alā allāhi

تَوكَّلْتُ عَلَىٰ ٱللَّه

Third: Imam al-Bāqir (`a) is reported to have said: say the following statement when he leaves his house

In the Name of Allah (I begin).

bismillāhi

Sufficient to me is Allah.

hasbiya allāhu

I put my trust in Allah.

all of my affairs

wa tawakkaltu `alā

allāhi

allāhumma innī

as'aluka khayra umūrī

kullihā

اسْالُكَ خَيْرَ امُورِي كُلِّهَا

and I pray Your protection against disgrace in this world and

O Allah, I beseech You for success in

chastisement in the Hereafter.

wa a`ūdhu bika min khizyi alddunyā wa adhābi al-ākhirati

كَ منْ خزْى ٱلدُّنْيَا وَعَذَابِ ٱلآخرَة

Fourth: Imam al-Şādiq (`a) is reported to have said: you are advised to say the following prayer:

tawakkaltu `alā allāhi

In the Name of Allah (I begin).

bismillāhi

In Allah I put my trust.

what I am leaving to do

There is neither might nor power

O Allah, I beseech You for success in

except with Allah.

lā hawla wa lā guwwata illā

billāhi

allāhumma innī as'aluka khayra mā kharajtu lahū

إنى اسالك خير ما خرجت له

and pray Your protection against failure in what I am leaving to do. wa a`ūdhu bika min sharri mā kharajtu lahū

واعوذ بك من شَرَ مَا خَرَجْتَ لَهُ

Fifth: Imam al-Riḍā (`a) is reported to have said: My father (`a) used to say the following when he would leave house:

In the Name of Allah; the Allbeneficent, the All-merciful.

I am leaving by the might and power of Allah.

but not by my own might or power;

rather, by the might and power of You, O Lord,

So, (please) provide me with it easily.

seeking Your sustenance.

bismillāhi alrrahmān alrrahīmi

Sixth: Imam al-Şādiq (`a) is reported to have said, "Whoever repeats Sūrah al-Tawhīd ten times before he leaves

Seventh: Imam Abu'l-Hasan Mūsā (`a) is reported to have said: When you intend to travel, you may stop at the door of your house and recite Sūrah al-Fātiḥah (No. 1) in front of you as well as to your right and left sides. You may also recite Sūrah al-Tawhīd, Sūrah al-Falaq (No. 113), and Sūrah al-Nās (No. 114). You may then say the following prayer:

O Allah, (please) safeguard me and safeguard whatever is with me,

keep me safe and keep safe whatever is with me,

and make me and whatever is with me reach my destination in a perfect way.

Eighth: Imam Mūsā al-Kāzim (`a) is also reported to have said you may say the following words:

In the Name of Allah (I begin), bismillāhi in Allah do I believe, āmantu billāhi نَّلْتُ عَلَىٰ ٱللَّه and in Allah do I put my trust. wa tawakkaltu `alā allāhi مَا شَاءَ ٱللَّهُ Only what Allah wills (shall come to mā shā'a allāhu pass).
