

The last day of Dhu'l-Ḥijjah is the last day in the Arabic calendar. Sayyid Ibn Ṭāwūs in his book of Iabāl al-A`māl, says it is recommended to offer a two unit prayer on this day reciting Sūrah al-Fātihah once, and repeating each of Sūrah al-Tawhīd and Āyah al-Kursī ten times. After the salat, it is recommended to say the following:

O Allah, as for any act that I have done in this year which You have warned me against doing and You have been displeased with it, I have forgotten it but You have not and You have called me to repent after I have dared to challenge You.

O Allah, I am now praying to You to forgive that action; so, please forgive me.

As for any action done that draws me near to You, Please accept it from me and never cut off my hope in You, O All-generous!
